Follow the instructions on the next page to get started. Once you have created an account, you can access all of your West Academic study aids with the same credentials at **subscription.westacademic.com**.




- 2 You will receive a verification link in the inbox of the email address you used to sign up. Before you get started, you'll need to verify your account by clicking the link in the email you've received.




Student Instructions


- 1 Sign in to eproducts.westacademic.com.

- 3 Click the eBook button to open the book in the online reader. The book is now available for offline reading in the RedShelf app.

Download the RedShelf app, available free in the Apple App or Google Play store.

In order to gain login credentials, you will need to create a password for the RedShelf app. Simply select “Forgot Password”, enter the email address associated with your West Academic Study Aids Collection account, and click the “Request Reset” button. You will receive an email with a password reset and should follow the instructions for creating a new password in order to sign in.

Books you have viewed within the online reader will appear in the RedShelf app the next time you sign in. Your notes and highlights will sync between the app and the online reader.
