Go to eproducts.westacademic.com and Create an Account or Sign In if you've already created an account with West Academic. Be sure to use your law school email address when creating an account.

You will receive a verification link in the inbox of the email address you used to sign up. Before you get started, you'll need to verify your account by clicking the link in the email you've received.

Your school's subscription to the West Academic Casebook Collection provides you with downloadable eBook versions of your required Foundation Press and West Academic Publishing casebooks, coursebooks, case supplements, statutory supplements, and other required add-on supplements.



Once you are logged in, look for the available casebooks located below "Materials Provided by My School" and click on your assigned casebook to add it to your bookshelf. **You can add multiple casebooks to your bookshelf.**







Once your casebook(s) are on your bookshelf, **click on a book to open the product detail page** and access your eBook.





Click the eBook button to view the book in the online eReader, take notes, and highlight.



You also have the option to purchase a print-on-demand softcover edition of your selected books, priced at the cost of printing and shipping. To purchase, click the "Buy Print on Demand" button and follow the prompts.

Note: print-on-demand books will take at least two weeks to arrive.
